



Tournament rules

Phaneuf Dunn Hockey 2024

Categories 2011 to 2015

- The tournament is a traditional 5-on-5 format, plus a goalie, who can be substituted if necessary.
- For the 2011 and 2012 categories, a maximum of 5 AAA-calibre players per team is allowed.
- For the 2011 D2 category, Hybrid body checking is accepted. The skates has to be in the same direction has the ouck carrier in order to finish a body check.
- Each game will last 2 periods of 10 minutes and a 3rd period of 12 minutes in stopped time.
- Each game will have a 3-minute warm-up time.
- Once a 5-goal difference has been reached, the third period of play will be timed in continuous time.
- At the end of each game, both teams must choose a minimum of 3 players for a shootout. A player may not take part in more than one shootout until all the other players on the team have participated.
- Shootout: 0.5 points for a shootout winner.
- From the semi-finals onwards, in case of a tie, extra time will be played at 3 against 3 to determine the winner.
- Each team will be allowed one 30 second timeout per game.
- Each team must be ready to start the game at least 10 minutes before their game.
- Each team must have identical uniforms (socks and jerseys) to play their games.
- After each game, teams will have 20 minutes to clean up and leave their locker room.
- Zero tolerance for intimidation and verbal abuse of referees.
- Our tournament is non-contact, so no checking will be tolerated.
- Each game will award 3 stars. The coach of the winning team must select the 1st and 3rd stars, and the coach of the losing team, the 2nd star. The choice of stars must be given to the timekeeper at the end of the game.
- Admission fee: \$10, which includes a chance to win one of our many prizes.
